

In his most recent progress report, chairman of the trust Paul Carew said a Lifemarkassessment of the Waiheke Road design was obtained and an architect incorporated floor layout adjustments for the proposed units to improve access and usability for elderly and disabled residents and guests.

The resource consent process is nearing completion, and James says once consent has been given, the building project will be full-speed ahead thanks to the generous support of Bayleys and other sponsors.
