Background:

The National Science Challenge Ageing Well project Life When Renting involves case studies in the Bay of Plenty, Marlborough and Waiheke Island. The Waiheke case study involved two phases of in-depth interviews with older renters. Our analysis of narratives revealed stories of uncertainty and hardship that challenge the glossy-brochure images of island life.

During this session we give an overview of key points from this study, relate these to a national perspective, and preview a follow-up study of coping with damp housing.

We also present and seek feedback on a prototype toolkit developed from the study to provide information about tenant rights, services and support for older renters.
